

Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Express by Holiday Inn, Oulton, Leeds on April 26th 2010 heard the following cases:

1. Christopher Young, of Hull University RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law MR10 (4) (i) on March 10th 2010, was suspended for 8 weeks and can resume playing on the 26th October 2010.
2. Thomas Hanson, of Old Brodleians RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (i) on March 27th 2010, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 14th September 2010.
3. Ryan Hammond, of Old Crossleyans RUFC, who was sent off for kicking, contrary to law TE10 (4) (c) on March 27th 2010, was suspended for 8 weeks and can resume playing on the 3rd May 2010.
4. Clinton North, of Ossett RUFC, who was sent off for dissent, contrary to law LE10 (4) (i) on March 27th 2010, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 27th April 2010.
5. David Perry, of Hemsworth RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on March 28th 2010, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on the 13th April 2010.
