

Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee, meeting at Rothwell Sports Centre, Oulton, Leeds on December 15th 2008 heard the following cases:

1. Christopher Willett, of Castleford RFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow card, contrary to law LE10 (4) (k) on November 8th 2008, sending off sufficient.
2. Kelvin Norton of Hornsea RFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (k) on November 8th 2008, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 30th December 2008.
3. Jonathan Hoggarth of Scarborough RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on November 8th 2008, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 23rd December 2008.
4. William Sellars of Huddersfield YMCA RFC, who was sent off for a head butt, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on November 16th 2008; sending off sufficient.
5. Gary Taylor of Huddersfield YMCA RFC, who was sent off for tripping contrary to law MR10 (4) (d) on November 15th 2008, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 9th December 2008.
6. Andrew Watson of Sandal RFC, who was sent off for stamping contrary to law MR10 (4) (b) on November 8th 2008, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 23rd December 2008.
7. Jason Conroy of Hullensians RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on the 29th November 2008, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on the 9th December 2008.

8. Simon Butterworth of Wath Upon Dearne RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on November 29th 2008, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 16th December 2008.

9. Nathan O'Connor of Rossington Hornets RFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle contrary to law LE10 (4) (e) on November 29th 2008, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 16th December 2008.

10. Christopher Walker, Coach of Wetherby RFC U16's, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on November 9th 2008, was suspended for 8 weeks from the touchline, changing rooms and contact with match officials on match days from the 24th November 2008 until the 19th January 2009.
