Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Express by Holiday Inn, Oulton, Leeds on December 19th 2011 heard the following cases:

1. Kerry Wood, of York RI RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (s), on November 5th 2011, was suspended for 5 weeks and can resume playing on the 24th January 2012.
2. Samuel Weller, of Selby RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (j) on November 26th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 17th January 2012.
3. Paddy Murray, of Skipton RUFC, who was sent off for contact with the eye, contrary to law 10 (4) (m) on November 26th 2011 sending off sufficient.
4. Jacob Crossland, of Castleford RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (j) on November 26th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 17th January 2012.
5. Ryan Hammond, of Old Crossleyans RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on November 5th 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 6th December 2011.
6. Dominic Georgiou, of Halifax RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (j) on November 20th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 13th December 2011.
7. Liam Goldthorpe of Cleckheaton RUFC, who was sent off for a head butt, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on November 19th 2011, was

- suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 13th December 2011.
8. Matthew Battie, of Wetherby RUFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards, contrary to law TE10 (4) (m) on November 12th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 10th January 2012.
 9. Liam Hogan, of Wetherby RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on November 12th 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 6th December 2011.
 10. Dave Robinson, of Hessle RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, on November 12th 2011, was suspended until he appears.
 11. Daren Robins, of Bramley Phoenix RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (e) on October 15th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 17th January 2012.
 12. James Fitch, of Acklam RUFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards, contrary to law LE10 (4) (m) on November 26th 2011, sending off sufficient.
 13. Ben Johnson, of Bishop Burton College RUFC, who was sent off for stamping, contrary to law MR10 (4) (b) on November 30th 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 23rd December 2011.

West Leeds RUFC – To continue with actions taken so far in relation to abuse of referees by spectators. Meeting to be held with Howard Madden and minutes of meeting to be sent to Disciplinary Committee.

Dinnington RUFC – Ben Cooper to be charged with physical abuse of a match official contrary to law 10(4) (s).
