Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Innkeepers Inn, Oulton, Leeds on December 21st 2009 heard the following cases:

1. Edward Ridley of Wensleydale RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law 5.12 on November 15th, sending off sufficient.
2. Richard Schmidt of Burley RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law MR10 (4) (k) on November 14th, was suspended for 10 weeks and can resume playing on the 23rd February 2010.
3. Benjamin Innes of York University RUFC, who was sent off for striking contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on November 25th, was suspended for 6 weeks and can resume playing on the 26th January 2010.
4. Keiron McMahon of Redcar RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on November 7th, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 19th January 2010.
5. Ryan Hayden of Morley RUFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on November 15th, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 8th December.
6. Steven Hayward of Castleford RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on November 28th, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 5th January 2010.
7. Jonathan Richards of Leodiensians RUFC, who was sent off for stamping, contrary to law TE10 (4) (b) on November 7th, was suspended for 7 weeks and can resume playing on the 29th December.

8. Melvin Waller of Stocksbridge RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on November 28th, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 29th December.

9. William De Preeze of York R.I RUFC, who was sent off for kicking, contrary to law LE10 (4) (c) on November 7th, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 19th January 2010.

10. Brian Wilcockson of Selby RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on November 28th, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 22nd December.

11. James Moore of Halifax Vikings RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law MR10 (4) (j) on November 14th, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 8th December.

12. Ryan Waudby, of Hull RUFC, who was sent off for tripping, contrary to law LE10 (4) (d) on November 28th, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on the 8th December.

13. James Fenwick of Thornensians RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (e) on November 21st, sending off sufficient.

14. Tommy Archer of Pontefract RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, threatening act to the referee on November 28th, was suspended until he appears.
