Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Express by Holiday Inn, Oulton, Leeds on January 16th 2012 heard the following cases:

1. Clifton Walker, of Thornensians RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (s), on December 3rd 2011, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 14th February 2012.
2. Matthew Ellis, of Moortown RUFC, who was sent off for kicking, contrary to law MR10 (4) (c) on December 3rd 2011, was suspended for 6 weeks and can resume playing on the 31st January 2012.
3. Gareth TathemBrugh, of Driffield RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (c) on December 3rd 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 24th January 2012.
4. Jacob Crossland, of Castleford RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (j) on November 26th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 17th January 2012.
5. Connor Carver, of Wharfedale RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (j) on December 11th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 30th December 2011.
6. Ian Duffus, of Northallerton RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law MR10 (4) (j) on December 10th 2011, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 31st January 2012.
7. Jason Whitehead of West Park Leeds RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on December 10th 2011, was

- suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on the 10th January 2012.
8. Stuart Heale, of Leodiensians RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (s) on December 17th 2011, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 14th February 2012.
 9. Christopher Squires, of Mosborough RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law MR10 (4) (s) on December 3rd 2011, was suspended for 7 weeks and can resume playing on the 7th February 2012.
 10. Thomas Marples, of Sheffield RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (e) on December 10th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 31st January 2012.
 11. Adam Wellington, of Bradford and Bingley RUFC, who was sent off for tripping, contrary to law LE10 (4) (d) on December 10th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 1st January 2012.
 12. Lisiata Tafa, of Bradford and Bingley RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on December 17th 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 7th February 2012.
 13. Jake Mulhern, of Sandal RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on December 17th 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 24th January 2012.
 14. Philip Harland, spectator, of Middlesbrough RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, 5.12 incident on December 10th 2011, was suspended from matches for 4 weeks.
