Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Express by Holiday Inn, Oulton, Leeds on January 4th 2012 heard the following cases:

1. Michael Ramsden, of Rawmarsh RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (s), on October 23rd 2010, was suspended for 6 weeks and can resume playing on the 14th December 2010.
2. Vincent Pemberton, of Burley RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on December 3rd 2011, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 31st January 2012.
3. James Griffen, of Burley RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on December 3rd 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 24th January 2012.
4. Richard Gordon, of Roundhegians RUFC, who was sent off on the 3rd December 2011 and suspended until he appears.
5. Lee Johnson, of Roundhegians RUFC, who was sent off on the 3rd December 2011 and suspended until he appears.

David Silkstone, coach of Dinnington U12's – Dinnington U12's vs Rotherham Phoenix U12's 13th November 2011 - 5.12 incident.

Banned from touchline for 8 weeks. Ban suspended until 31st December 2012. Ban to lapse if no further incidents.

Dinnington RUFC to have further meeting with Coaches to reinforce regulation that Coaches should not enter field of play. Minutes to be sent to Disciplinary Committee. Dinnington RUFC to put up notices in clubhouse informing club that they had appeared before the Yorkshire

Disciplinary Committee on 5.12 charge. Copy of notice to be sent to Disciplinary Committee.

Simon Bunting, spectator of Rotherham Phoenix U12's – to appear at Disciplinary meeting on 23rd January 2012.

Heath RUFC – Citing of Miles Fairbank by Huddersfield YMCA, charge was dismissed.
