

Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee, meeting at Rothwell Sports Centre, Oulton, Leeds on January 14th, 2008 heard the following cases:

1. Paul Summerland, of Adwick Le Street RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on November 24th, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 11th December 2007.
2. Richard Smith of Old Otliensians RFC, who was sent off for striking contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on November 24th, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 18th December 2007.
3. Stuart Davies of York RFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards contrary to law TE10 (4) (k) on November 24th, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 11th December 2007.
4. Ben Brickell of Sheffield University RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on December 5th, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 12th February 2008.
5. Neil Mears of Hemsworth RFC, who was sent off for striking on November 24th, case dismissed.
6. Lee Land of Castleford RFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards, contrary to law TE10 (4) (k) on December 1st,, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 18th December 2007.
7. Simon Howarth of Wheatley Hills RFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) December 22nd, was suspended until he appears.

8. Anthony Woss, of Selby RFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on December 22nd, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on 22nd January 2008.

9. Javesh Patel of Hull University RFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on 28th November, was suspended until he appears.

10. Matthew Horn of Old Crossleyans RFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on 1st December, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 1st January 2008.
