

Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Express by Holiday Inn, Oulton, Leeds on January 25th, 2010 heard the following cases:

1. Tommy Archer, of Pontefract RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee and threatening action towards the referee, contrary to law MR10 (4) (k) on November 28th 2009, was suspended for 20 weeks and can resume playing on April 20th 2010.
2. David Hoyle of West Park Leeds RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on December 12th 2009, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 29th December 2009.
3. Lee Warley of Bridlington RUFC, who was sent off for a verbal abuse of the referee and threatening action towards the referee contrary to law MR10 (4) (k) on December 12th 2009 was suspended for 16 weeks and can resume playing on April 20th 2010.
4. Mark Floyd of Bridlington RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law MR10 (4) (k) on December 12th 2009, was suspended for 8 weeks and can resume playing on February 23rd 2010.
5. Lawrence Pierce of Bishop Burton College RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle contrary to law MR10 (4) (i) on December 15th 2009, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on February 2nd 2010.
6. Adam Atkinson of Hessle RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on January 2nd 2010, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on February 2nd 2010.
7. Greg Robinson of Redcar RUFC, who was sent off for stamping, was suspended until he appears.

Old Brodleians RUFC – 5.12 incident Old Brodleians U16's vs. Scunthorpe U16's on November 22nd 2009. Actions taken in response to incident considered appropriate. Touch judge involved to be warned to his future conduct. Notices to be posted in Clubhouse. Copy of notice to be sent to Disciplinary Committee.
