

Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Express by Holiday Inn, Oulton, Leeds on March 15th 2010 heard the following cases:

1. Derek Eves, of Pontefract RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (i) on January 23rd 2010, was suspended for 8 weeks and can resume playing on the 11th May 2010.
2. Goran Jelenic, of Beverley RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on February 27th 2010, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 16th March 2010.
3. David Reed, of Castleford RUFC, who was sent off for stamping, contrary to law MR10 (4) (b) on February 6th 2010, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 30th March 2010.
4. Mark Docking, of Moortown RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (i) on February 7th 2010, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 30th March 2010.
5. Phil Martin, Coach of Moortown U19's RUFC, who was sent off for a verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (i) on February 7th 2010, was given a touchline ban from the 8th February until the 8th March 2010.

8. Jarvis Ellis, of St Johns University York RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on February 10th 2010, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 30th March 2010.

9. Andrew Shaw, of Huddersfield YMCA RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (i) on February 20th 2010, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 22nd March 2010.

10. Simon Howarth, of Wheatley Hills RUFC, who was sent off for kneeling, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on February 20th 2010, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 16th March 2010.

11. Andrew Hucker, of Guisborough RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on February 13th 2010, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 2nd March 2010.

12. Hugh Gumbs, of Old Otliensians RUFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law MR10 (4) (e) on February 6th 2010, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 9th March 2010.

13. Simon Butterworth, of Wath Upon Dearne RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on February 13th 2010, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 2nd March 2010.
