Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Express by Holiday Inn, Oulton, Leeds on November 21st 2011 heard the following cases:

1. Alexander Simmons, of Leodiensians RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law MR10 (4) (s), on September 24th 2011, was suspended for 8 weeks and can resume playing on the 6th December 2011.
2. Simon Horwell, of York RI RUFC, who was sent off for a head butt, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on October 15th 2011, was suspended for 8 weeks and can resume playing on the 31st January 2012.
3. Ryan Donnelly, of Dinnington RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law TE10 (4) (a) on September 24th 2011, was suspended for 5 weeks and can resume playing on the 8th November 2011.
4. Stephen Johnson, of Redcar RUFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards, contrary to law TE10 (4) (m) on October 29th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 6th December 2011.
5. David Fox, of North Ribblesdale RUFC, who was sent off for a 5.12 incident, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on October 22nd 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 6th December 2011.
6. Andrew Eneoldsen, of Sheffield RUFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards, contrary to law TE10 (4) (m) on October 22nd 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 6th December 2011.

 9. Matthew Baldwin, of Sheffield University RUFC, who was sent off for a head butt, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on November 2nd 2011, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 13th December 2011.
 10. Shane Brown, of Hornsea RUFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, on October 29th 2011, was suspended until he appears.
 11. Jamie Pickard, of Bramley Phoenix RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on October 29th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 29th November 2011.
 12. Josh Woodhead, of Bramley Phoenix RUFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law TE10 (4) (a) on November 5th 2011, was suspended for 8 weeks and can resume playing on the 17th January 2012.
 13. Ryan Pilley, of Thornensians RUFC, who was sent off for kicking, contrary to law LE10 (4) (c) on November 5th 2011, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 29th November 2011.
 14. Craig Jeffles, of Castleford RUFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards, contrary to law TE10 (4) (m) on November 5th 2011, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 6th December 2011.
 15. Dales Joburns, of Hemsworth RUFC, who was sent off for dissent, contrary to law LE10 (4) (m) on November 5th 2011, was suspended for 6 weeks and can resume playing on the 4th January 2012.
 16. Michael Wilson, of Old Otliensians RUFC, who was sent off for racial abuse on the 29th April 2006. Contact with Baildon RUFC to make

sure there are no outstanding fines. Sufficient procedures in place to guarantee action will be taken if necessary.
