

# Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee, meeting at Innkeepers Lodge Oulton, Leeds on November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2009 heard the following cases:

1. Charlie Spon-Smith of Sheffield Tigers RFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle contrary to law LE10 (4) (e) on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on October 13<sup>th</sup>.
2. Ian Morgan of Acklam RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law TE10 (4) (a) on September 26<sup>th</sup>, was suspended for 12 weeks and can resume playing on December 29<sup>th</sup>.
3. Adam Knights of Pontefract RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on 13<sup>th</sup> October.
4. David Thorpe of Pontefract RFC, who was sent off for stamping contrary to law MR10 (4) (b) on September 26<sup>th</sup>, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on December 1<sup>st</sup>.
5. Martin Moffatt of Thornensians RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, was suspended for 5 weeks and can resume playing on November 17<sup>th</sup>.
6. Jack Botham of Marist RFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (k) on October 24<sup>th</sup>, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on December 8<sup>th</sup>.
7. Ben Woolley of Ossett RFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on October 17<sup>th</sup>, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
8. Paul Bissett, Coach of Burley RFC, who was sent off verbal abuse of the referee, was banned for 6 months, suspended until the end of the season.
9. Andrew Watson of York RI RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on December 1<sup>st</sup>.
10. Jonathan Brown of Northallerton RFC, who was sent off for tripping contrary to law LE10 (4) (d) on October 10<sup>th</sup>, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on December 1<sup>st</sup>.
11. Simon Moore of Middlesbrough RFC, who was sent off for tackling without the ball contrary to law LE10 (4) (f) on October 24<sup>th</sup>, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

12. Richard Piper of Cleckheaton RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on October 10th, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
13. Craig Field of Morley RFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle contrary to law MR10 (4) (i) on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on December 12<sup>th</sup>.
14. Simon Drury of Ossett RFC, who was sent off for dissent contrary to law LE10 (4) (k), was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on December 14<sup>th</sup>.
