

Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee, meeting at Rothwell Sports Centre, Oulton, Leeds on October 20th 2008 heard the following cases:

1. Ian Pugsley, Coach of Yorkshire RFUW, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee, contrary to law LE10 (4) (k) on May 11th, was suspended from the touchline until 17th November and until the 31st December for Yorkshire RFUW.
2. Shane Sellers of Pocklington RFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on September 20th, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on the 21st October.
3. Thomas Butterfield of Huddersfield YMCA RFC, who was sent off for stamping contrary to law TE10 (4) (k) on October 4th was suspended for 6 weeks and can resume playing on the 18th November.
4. Richard Hellstrom of Hornsea RFC, who was sent off for punching, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on September 27th, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on the 7th October.
5. Lee Marrow of Marist RFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards contrary to law LE10 (4) (k) on October 4th, sending off sufficient.
6. James Maycock of Moortown RFC, who was sent off for punching contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on September 20th, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on the 11th November.
