## **Disciplinary Hearing**

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee meeting at Express by Holiday Inn, Oulton, Leeds on October 24<sup>th</sup> 2011 heard the following cases:

1. Danny Booth, of Old Crossleyans RUFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards, contrary to law TE10 (4) (m) on October 8<sup>th</sup> 2011, was suspended for 1 week and can resume playing on the 18<sup>th</sup> October 2011.

Scarborough RUFC – Abandoned match, September 11th 2011, Scarborough U19's vs. Beverley U19s

Players warned to their future actions. Notices to be put up informing Club members of possible sanctions for whole Club for such incidents. Copy to be sent to Disciplinary Committee. Report to be made to Club Senior Committee making them aware of severity of sanctions the U19's and/or the Club could face. Minutes to be sent to Disciplinary Committee. Further meeting to be held with Players of U19's to stress repercussions that could result from a repeat of these incidents. Minutes to be sent to Disciplinary Committee. League points won on the day (6) to be deducted from Scarborough.

Beverley RUFC – Meeting to be arranged with U19 players to stress the possible seriousness for the Club if they are involved in an abandoned match.
