

Disciplinary Hearing

A Yorkshire RFU Ltd Disciplinary Committee, meeting at Rothwell Sports Centre, Oulton, Leeds on September 29th, 2008 heard the following cases:

1. William Robinson, of Doncaster RFC, who was sent off for striking, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on April 5th, was suspended for 3 weeks and can resume playing on 23rd September.
2. Dane Robson of Marist RFC, who was sent off for striking, contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on March 29th, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 30th September.
3. Andrew Murphy of Marist RFC, who was sent off for verbal abuse of the referee contrary to law LE10 (4) (k) on March 29th, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 30th September.
4. Andrew Hoyle of Halifax Vandals RFC, who was sent off for a dangerous tackle, contrary to law LE10 (4) (e) on August 30th, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 16th September.
5. Kristopher Whata of Bradford Salam RFC, who was sent off for striking contrary to law LE10 (4) (k) on September 13th, was suspended for 5 weeks and can resume playing on the 4th November.
6. Mark Sutcliffe of Knottingley RFC, who was sent off for 2 yellow cards on 20th September, sending off sufficient.
7. Gareth Richardson of Heath RFC, who was sent off for striking contrary to law MR10 (4) (a) on September 13th, was suspended for 4 weeks and can resume playing on the 28th October.

8. Michael Damby of Hullensians RFC, who was sent off for striking, contrary to law LE10 (4) (a) on September 13th, was suspended for 2 weeks and can resume playing on the 30th September.
